1840 CENSUS, TENNESSEE

The figures following each name represent composition of the family by age and sex. Each digit stands for a number in the column on the original schedule (zeros omitted after the last number inserted).

Columns on the schedules are, in order, males 0-5 years, males 5-10, males 10-15, males 15-20, males 20-30, males 30-40, males 40-50, males 50-60, males 60-70, males 70-80, males 80-90, males 90-100, males over 100. To the right of these are 13 identical columns for females.

A household with figures as follows:

120001-103001001

means it was composed of 1 male under 5, 2 males 5-10, and 1 male 30-40; 1 female under 5, 3 females 10-15, 1 female 30-40 and 1 female 60-70.

This transcription does not include statistical detail on Blacks, either free or slave, though "free colored" are shown by name where they were heads of household. You will notice a number of names followed by 0-0. These are Blacks who fit the "free colored" category.
