STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA: AT A COURT OF PLEAS & QUARTER SESSION HELD AND HEID FOR THE
COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM AT THE COURT HOUSE IN THE TOWN OF WENTWORTH ON THE 4th MONDAY OF
NOVEMBER 1822, THE FOLLOWING PROCEEDINGS WERE HAD AS FOLLOWS TO WIT:

ALEXANDER GRADY COMES INTO OPEN COURT AND MAKES OATH THAT HE SERVED IN THE ARMY OF
THE UNITED STATES, CAPTAIN LANDERS DONOHO'S COMPANY IN FIRST CORPS OF ARTILLERY WITH
ABRAHAM JARRELL, A PRIVATE IN SAID COMPANY FOR THE TERM OF 3 YEARS & BETTER, THAT SAID JARRELL
WAS DISCHARGED WITH HONOR BY CAPTAIN LANDERS (SANDERS) DONOHO WHO SAID THAT HE HAD SERVED
FOR THE TERM OF FIVE YEARS ON OR ABOUT THE 25th DAY OF JULY 1817, AT FORT SCOTT IN THE
ALABAMA, THAT IT IS REPORTED THAT HE DIED ON HIS WAY HOME, THAT HE KNEW HIM WELL AND HIS
FAMILY AMONGST WHOM IT IS GENERALLY BELIEVED THAT HE IS DEAD.

LIEVED AND REPORTED AMONGST HIS FAMILY THAT HE DIED ON HIS WAY HOME AFTER BEING DISCHARGED
AND THAT HE HIMSELF (WILLIAM JARRELL) BELIEVETH THE SAME: THAT HE WAS NEVER MARRIED AND LEFT
BROTHERS AND SISTERS AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT: WILLIAM, THOMAS, JOSHUA, VALENTINE, CLABORN, BETSY
AND POLLY. THAT BETSY MARRIED JOHN BROWN AND DIED LEAVING ONE CHILD, PARTHENA BROWN; AN
INFANT, THAT HIS MOTHER AND FATHER ARE BOTH DEAD.
