

This Indenture made and borne this first day of February 1791
Between John Wansley sent of the County of Albemarle
and State of Virginia of the one part and Nathaniel Wansley
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that the said John Wansley for sundry good causes but more
Especially for and in consideration of two hundred pounds
current money of Virginia to me in hand paid the
Receipt whereof I do hereby confess and acknowledge hath
this day and date bargained sold and delivered unto said
Wansley six head of Horses to wit ten of mare colts and horns
eleven head of Horses Colts, eighteen head of Hogs five sheep
and also all kitchen and Plantation Furniture as also three
seats beds and furniture. Given under my hand and
seal this day and year above written
