yearling 1 Shee five years old 2
Bull calves and one Cow Calf
in case the said Rebecca doth find
it to be contrary to her marriage
contract provided by the
marriage contract and doth
find in this Court that the said Rebecca
White died under age and before
marriage it is therefore declared
that John West the surviving
of the said Henry White do find
unto the said Joseph and
Henry White Wittors slaves and
things as aforesaid the sum
of one hundred Sterling
and all this the Estate above said
to be paid unto Collo John West
