THREE OTHER FAMILIES BY THE NAME OF MATHEWS PROBABLY RELATED TO SOME OF THE MATHEWS FAMILIES IN BRUNSWICK CO. VA.

A. THE FAMILY OF MR. J. C. MATHEWS OF GAY, GEORGIA.

Mr. J. C. Mathews has a will of Isaac Mathews, made in Halifax Co. Va. in 1767,⁽¹⁾ in which he mentions his wife's name as Mary. On the back of this will is a note written by one Moses Mathews to his mother Mary Mathews. This Moses was not mentioned in Isaac's will. Mr. J. C. Mathews believes that this Moses Mathews was the same person as his ancestor Moses Mathews, who owned land in Winfield District So. Car in 1756, moved to Lincoln Co. Ga. in 1783 and died 1806. He married Sallie Findley in 1748 and had five sons and two daughters as follows:
