He quotes a history of the Baptist Church in Georgia which says that Moses Mathews was born in Va. of a poor family in 1725,⁽¹⁾ married in Va. in 1748 or 1749 and moved to So. Car. in 1750. This history also says that Moses' eldest son, Rev. James Mathews, was born in Va. in 1749 or 1750.

B. THE FAMILY OF JAMES MATHEWS⁽²⁾ OF HALIFAX CO. NORTH CAROLINA⁽³⁾

James Mathews married Sarah Brinkley. They came to Warren Co. and then to Morgan Co. Ga. Both are buried in Greensboro, Ga. They had eleven children as follows:

1. John Mathews (born 1766-67) Halifax, N. C. married Mary (Polly) Burt⁽⁴⁾ Nov. 12, 1793, Halifax Co., N. C. Mary (Polly) Burt born 1778, Halifax Co., John Mathews died 1822 in Autauga Co., Ala. Polly Mathews died 1835 in Wilcox Co., Ala. and was buried in Autauga Co., Ala.
2. Margaret Mathews, married Chas. Furlow of Greene Co., Ga. and Warren Co. Ga. 1809.
3. Charles Mathews, married Sarah Fitzpatrick March 7, 1813, Morgan County Records.
