I do hereby certify that to all to whom it may concern I have a certain containing  
hundred acres between Richland County and the County of Sumner the County of our State  
and I have I thought situated between the County of the other part  
concerning the boundary of the tract of land whereon the said Richland and  
and I have now made the said tract of land having been conveyed by and  
of the trustees of the said Richland County bearing date 1791 and  
the term day of said tract being also, <sup>and</sup> the boundary of the tract  
land sold him by James E Wright and also a part of the boundary  
of said Kelly land sold him by Mrs John and the said parties  
having agreed to arbitrate and settle all matters and controversies between  
them to and having referred to said persons did on the 16th day of  
Aug 1835 choose ministers and appoint Charles Stone though I cannot  
of our County to arbitrate to settle upon and for the proper boundary  
between the said tract of land as far as it is the boundary of the tract  
and the said Kelly land and I am thus to that the said Charles Stone  
and the said John and the said Kelly land as aforesaid having

the evidence produced and laid before us by the above parties  
 do award as follows by the division line between said parties shall begin  
 at a Post oak on James Glenn line Richard Hootby & Victorine Bradley  
 old corner and run thence South 61° East so as to just close the woods and  
 celly east of where James Hootby & his sons formerly stood and old stone  
 mark stands N. 38° E. to a stake - on the line and James Hootby &  
 old line which East corner shall also be a corner of David Phelps land  
 there we do give them award that the said parties do remain satisfied  
 with the above award division line and do continue all disputes and  
 controversies concerning or having relation thereto hence forth & forever  
 from under our hands and seals this 18th day of May in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six and of the  
 Independence and sixtieth year of the United States of America the district
